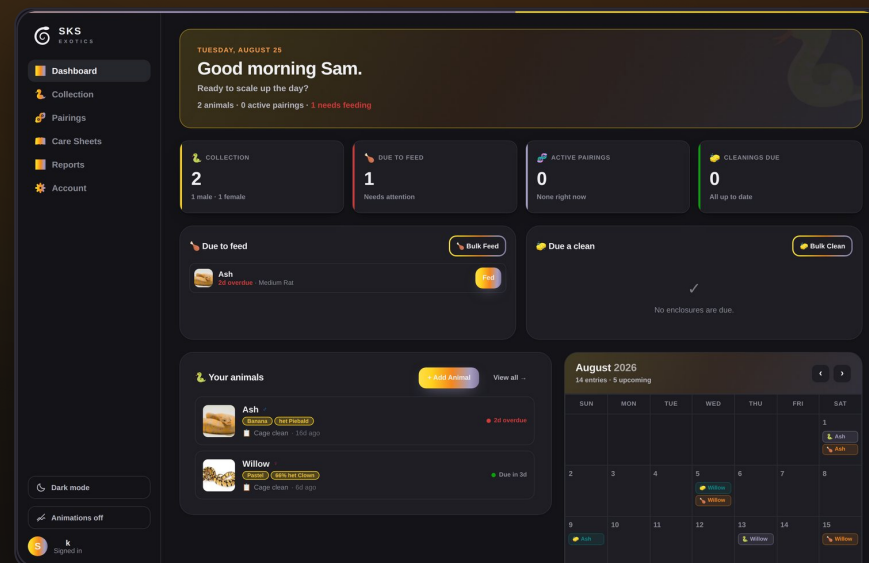




WELCOME ABOARD

Everything your collection knows, **written down once.**

Feeding, sheds, weights, cleaning, pairings, genetics and clutch records — recorded as you go and there when you need them. On your phone at the rack, on your laptop at the desk.



A collection outgrows memory long before it outgrows the rack

Ask a keeper when a particular female last refused a meal, what she weighed before she went off feed, or which male she locked with in March, and the honest answer is usually **a notebook, a photo roll, and a good memory**. That works at three animals. It does not work at thirty, and it certainly does not work two seasons later when it matters most.

1 Record it once, in the moment

Log a feed in two taps at the rack. Everything downstream — the next due date, the calendar, the reports — works itself out from what you entered.

2 Nothing is calculated twice

Feeding intervals, hatch-rate percentages, clutch profit, cost per animal. You enter facts; the arithmetic is the app's problem.

3 It answers questions you will actually ask

Which animals are overdue. What that clutch really cost. Whether this pairing is worth repeating. Which rack she is in.

4 Your records stay yours

Export everything to Excel or PDF whenever you like. No lock-in, and nothing is ever deleted because a subscription lapsed.

DUE TODAY

Overdue animals surface first and in red. Mark one fed straight from the dashboard without opening its profile.

BULK ACTIONS

Feed or clean a whole rack in one pass — tick the animals, set the prey and size once, and every record is written separately.

CALENDAR

Past entries and projected due dates on one month view, colour-coded by the kind of record.

QUARANTINE

New arrivals get a thirty-day clock. The dashboard says who is still serving and who is ready to come off.

YOUR ANIMALS

A real record for every animal, not a row in a spreadsheet

Photographs, full genetics, weights over time, every meal and refusal, sheds, vet visits, and where in the room it actually lives.

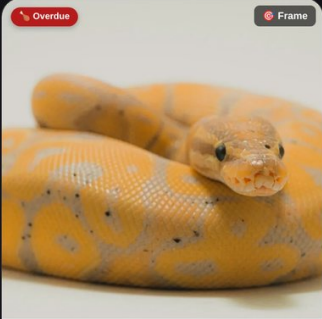

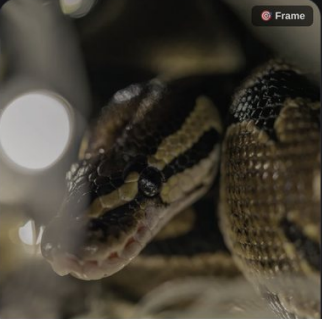

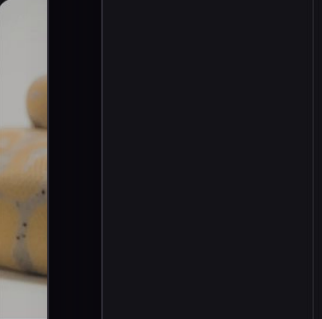

A season, from first introduction to hatchlings on the ground

Pair two animals and see the odds for every possible hatchling before you commit. Then log each stage as it happens — the status, the timeline and the reports all follow from it.

THINGS TO WATCH

No female weigh-ins logged for this pairing yet

WHAT TO LOOK FOR

First shed usually around 7–14 days, first meal after that

Give the female a long rest and steady feeding to rebuild condition

Record what worked — next season you will want these dates

Typical ball python intervals — individual animals vary, and your own records beat any table.

GENETICS CALCULATOR

Every possible outcome with its probability, worked from the parents' recorded morphs. Visuals, hets and possible hets handled separately.

EVERY STAGE TRACKED

Introduction, locks, ovulation, pre-lay shed, eggs down, incubation, hatch. Each one dated, with the timeline drawn for you.

CLUTCHES AND HATCHLINGS

Record eggs, fertile, slugs and hatched. Hatchlings become animals in your collection, linked back to the clutch they came from.

What the season actually did — including what it cost

Four reports, built only from records you have already entered. Every one of them exports to Excel and PDF.

Revenue is what the hatchlings from that clutch actually sold for. Cost is expenses tagged to the clutch plus the food those hatchlings have eaten. Female eats whether or not she produces, and loading a season's feeding onto one clutch would make every clutch look like a loss. "Still to sell"

ANIMAL REPORT

One animal in full — feeding history, weight curve, every event, exportable as a record you can hand to a buyer or a vet.

BREEDING REPORT

The season at a glance: pairings, fertility rate, hatch rate, and which pairings produced what.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Revenue against spend, cost per animal, feed actually eaten, and clutch profit and loss with the parents' keep deliberately excluded.

COLLECTION REPORT

The whole collection summarised — sexes, morphs, ages and value.

CARE SHEETS

Husbandry references for the species people actually keep, with the sources cited so you can check them yourself.

BRING YOUR COLLECTION WITH YOU

Import from a spreadsheet — names, sexes, genetics, weights, last feed and location. A template is provided, and every row is checked before anything is written.

TAKE IT AWAY AGAIN

Export everything, any time, on any plan. Excel and PDF. Your records are yours and we would rather you never felt trapped by them.

WORKS ON THE PHONE

Built for a phone in one hand at the rack, and a laptop at the desk. The same account, the same records, kept in step.

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GETTING STARTED

Your account is already open

You are on the free plan. No card was asked for and none is needed.

A name and a photo is all the form needs to start.

Log a feeding
The next due date works itself out from there.

Log a clean
Same idea, for enclosures.

Put a pair together
See the odds before you commit to anything.

Read the reports
Which is what all the logging was for.

Free start here	\$0 forever	Up to 5 animals and 3 pairings . Every feature — full records, genetics calculator, all four reports, care sheets and exports. No card, no trial clock.

A lapsed subscription never costs you records. Everything you have logged stays readable and exportable — you simply cannot add beyond the free limits until you subscribe again.

Start with what you have
Add one animal and see how it feels. The app comes with an example collection already in it, so nothing is a blank screen on day one — and clearing it takes one click.
